What Personal Data is held?

Names, contact details, educational setting, SEND, health issues (where relevant), social services involvement (where relevant), ethnic group (optional question), records of contacts and meetings attended.

How will the data be stored?

On a secure encrypted database, to which only IASS staff have access. Paper records are kept in locked filing cabinets and drawers, in a secure building.

What is the legal basis for the collection, use and storage of the data?

We process data because it is necessary in order to provide information, advice and support carried out in the public interest under s.32 of the Children and Families Act 2014.

Give details of how long the data will be stored and criteria used to determine this?

Paper records are held only so long as required by the case and then are destroyed as confidential waste. Database records will be retained for the duration of SEN Support or Education Health and Care Plan and will be anonymised (kept only for statistical purposes) when the young person reaches the age of 25, or earlier on request).

Who will it be shared with and for what purpose?

Reading IASS for SEND operates a confidential service and information will only be shared outside the service with the consent of the service user, except in situations where a safeguarding concern has arisen.
